SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES
4.1 Description of first aid measures:

The symptoms resulting from intoxication can appear after exposure, therefore, in case of doubt, seek medical attention for direct exposure to the chemical product or persistent discomfort, showing the SDS of this product.

If blisters form on the skin, these should never be burst as this will increase the risk of infection.

By eye contact:
